



Feature Focus: Find Your "Orphan" File Links

Virtually every GoldMine system has an ongoing "orphan" link problem. Did you know that with the press of a button GoldVisionPro will find all the file links in a GoldMine system that are no longer accessible (orphaned)? In the GoldVisionPro Link Viewer, select the "Run (List Links)" button for All Contacts' file links, then select the "Analyze Links" button. GoldVisionPro will create an error list of all the "orphan" links, along with a brief description of the problem (e.g., drive not found, file not found, etc.).

Local file-linking (e.g., creating a link to a file in C:\My Documents) is one of the primary causes of linked files being inaccessible across a network. Drive failure, inadequate backup, and user deletion are other causes. User frustration with "Exploring" the network to save and link files properly usually results in limited use of this powerful file linking feature in GoldMine.

GoldVisionPro solves this problem by automatically moving files to the proper network location when links are created, so that links will be accessible by all authorized users, and centralized files are available for regular system backup.
